He/She is also responsible for planning and conducting a variety of safe, fun and interesting activities in an outdoor setting. Above all, a Counselor must have a sincere and energetic desire to have a quality-oriented and consistent experience with children.

Qualifications

- + Ability to teach and lead various recreational activities.
- + Excellent character, integrity and adaptability.
- + Ability to communicate and work with a variety of ages and skill levels.
- + The desire and ability to work in a cooperative, team-oriented atmosphere.
- + Enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience and self-control.
- + Responsible, friendly, enthusiastic, patient and willing to learn.
- + Should participate in counselor training events throughout the year.
- + Must pass a background check.

Responsibilities

- + Must supervise campers, ensuring proper attention to health, happiness, discipline and safety.
- + To encourage participation in camp activities and social interaction among all campers.
- + To recognize and respond to situations in which group problem solving is necessary.
- + To provide opportunities for the group so that each individual experiences success while at camp.
- + To encourage respect for personal property, camp equipment and facilities.
- + To set a good example for campers in all areas, including cleanliness, punctuality, clean-up chores, rules, and sportsmanship
- + To lead campers by example with regard to personal appearance, dining etiquette and relationships with others.
- + To encourage and assist campers to successfully participate in all camp activities.
- + To observe camper behavior, assess its appropriateness, enforce proper safety regulations and emergency procedures and apply suitable behavior-management techniques.
- + To communicate regularly with "Coordinadores" regarding concerns, updates and challenges.
- + To work with camp directors and /or pertinent camp staff in order to overcome potential difficulties with the facilities, program, campers and/or other staff members.
- + To take turns with other counselors for various responsibilities.
- + Set a good example in EVERYTHING you do at camp.
- + To help develop, carry out and evaluate a camp program that reflects the goals of Camp La Llanada's philosophy "Con eficiencia y guaguancó".
